I duly received Mr. Buchanan's letter of the 27th ultimo, regarding a proposal to extend the service of this ship to cover the Spanish Coast and the Bay of Biscay, and shall be glad if you will inform the Owners that the main items governing the service of this vessel are the thickness of the shell plating and the strength of the bottom and lower side longitudinals. While the strength of the longitudinals could be increased, it is not considered practicable to compensate for the deficiency in thickness of the shell plating.
