In confirmation of our telephonic conversations respecting the Motorship "JACO", I have to acquaint you that the question of the fees charged by the Curacao Surveyor in consequence of his survey in January last was raised with him.

As a result of these enquiries, I am now in receipt of a communication in which the Surveyor states that there is a standard scale of fees for all ships which, in his opinion, is fair and reasonable for the port.

He adds that for a Seaworthy Certificate Fls.100 is charged and for Damage Reports Fls.125. If there are extensive repairs to be carried out, the fee is increased accordingly.
