80% of the construction was carried out under the supervision of this Society, and the remaining 20% without this Society.

Plans for conversion to a horse and cattle transport vessel and assignment of the symbol \oplus have been approved.

No First Entry report has been forwarded, but this was not requested in endorsement 29.4.47.

The requirements of a Periodical Special Survey have been complied with.

This vessel appears to have been built and altered in accordance with the Rules and the approved plans, and it is submitted she is eligible to be classed \oplus "With freeboard" "For Coasting Service Oslofjord, 1,48 Cpn. Kattegat & Baltic, also SS Cpn - 1,48. Hamburg via Kiel Canal".

The Summer Freeboard as shown on the attached extract from the Freeboard Verification Form, now marked on the vessel's sides, to be inserted in the classification certificate, and recorded in the Register Book, and further the remaining freeboards, as shown on the accompanying extract, to be inserted in the certificate of classification.
