Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "ANGIOLINA R.", ex "VIRGINIA DOLLAR", concerning which the Society's Surveyors at Genoa have been in communication with your goodselves, I beg to acquaint you that the Committee of this Society have had before them to-day a cabled message from the Surveyors to the effect that the vessel is at present preparing to sail, and that the Special Survey No. 2 prescribed by the Society's Rules, which is overdue, is not being proceeded with.

In the circumstances the Committee much regret that there is no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the Rules.

I have to add that upon the receipt of a satisfactory report from the Society's Surveyors to the effect that the necessary Special Survey and all necessary repairs have been carried out, the case of the vessel will be submitted to the Committee with a view to the reinstatement of her character.
