



Built at Belfast by Messrs. Workman, Clark & Co. Ltd. in 1903 - 2 mo. and classed 100A1 "Awning deck with Freeboard".  
S.S. No.3 - 7,15. S.S. No.1 - 19.

OWNERS: Societa Anonima Italiana Prodotti Metallici, Turin.

  
This vessel sustained damage through heavy weather in February last, and Mr. French proceeded to Honolulu at the request of the Owners where temporary repairs were effected to enable the vessel to continue her voyage to the Far East and New York, and it was recommended that the vessel be placed in dry dock on arrival at New York for further examination and permanent repairs.

The vessel was afterwards sold to the present Owners, and arrived at Genoa on the 1st September, 1924.

In reply to enquiries as to the Owners' intentions regarding the carrying out of the Second Special Survey No.2, which became due in July 1923, and permanent repairs, the Genoa Surveyors stated on the 15th October last that the Owners were considering whether they should retain the vessel's class or break her up.

The following cablegram has now been received from the Genoa Surveyors :-

"VIRGINIA DOLLAR S.S.NO2 IS NOT BEING PROCEEDED WITH VESSEL  
"PREPARING TO SAIL".

It is submitted that in view of the Second Special Survey No.2 not having been held, and the year of grace having expired in July last, the vessel's class should be expunged from the Register Book with a red line indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
