With reference to my letter of the 13th instant relative to the steamer "VIRGINIA DOLLAR", I have to acquaint you that this vessel retains her class subject to the donkey boiler not being used until satisfactorily reported upon; to the wing furnaces of the forward starboard boiler being examined, the limit on which expired at the end of May last, and to the front end plates of the forward starboard and two after boilers being repaired at an early date. I have also to inform you that the steamer will be eligible for the records * LMC-MS 4,23, B.S. 11,23 when the front end plates of the forward starboard and two after boilers have been repaired and the port and starboard M.P. Cylinders and pistons and the sea connections examined.

I shall be glad if you will be guided accordingly.

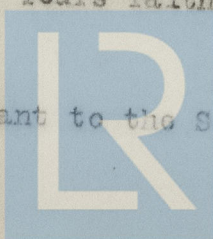
