M.S. "Hallfried"

Mtd: - $375'-0" \times 51'-3" \times \begin{cases} 25'-7\frac{1}{2}" \text{ to } 2^{\text{nd}} \text{ deck} \\ 34'-1\frac{1}{2}" \text{ to } \text{Super.} \end{cases}$

As a full scantling flush-decked ship having moulded depth of $34'-1\frac{1}{2}"$ to the upper deck and with 50% excess sheer, the summer moulded draught = $26'-3\frac{1}{2}"$

As a Complete Superstructure Ship with a moulded depth of $26'-1\frac{1}{2}"$ to the 3rd deck, i.e. with 8ft standard height of lower decks, the summer moulded draught = $28'-6\frac{1}{2}"$

W. assignment appears like $25'-6"$
