The Classing Committee and the Classification Department are concerned to note how very much in arrears are your Machinery First Entry Reports on the "Iphigenia" and the "Iridina".

The Hull report on the former is No. 10834 and is dated the 8th April, 1955. The latter is dated the 3rd August, 1955.

I have to draw your attention to the terms of Circular 2001, in which you will note that you are required to write a personal explanation to the Committee in all cases in which a Report is delayed for any reason.
