M.S. "WOLFE ISLANDER"

We acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 20th ult.,
in connection with surveys overdue on the above named ship.

The ship is used as a ferry between Kingston, Ontario,
and Wolfe Island - a short, protected service for which no load
line is required. She operates each season from early in April,
when the ice breaks up, until sometime in December when the
waterway becomes icebound.

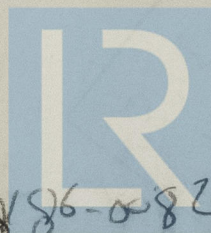
We have written previously about overdue annual surveys
and no replies were received, perhaps because the ferry is owned
by the Ontario Department of Highways and is operated by the
Township Council of Wolfe Island and there appeared to be doubt
as to who should assume authority regarding a decision concern-
ing retention of class. The ferry is regularly surveyed by the
Department of Steamship Inspection.

We now enclose copy of Township of Wolfe Island letter
of April 1st informing us that continuation of class is not
wanted.

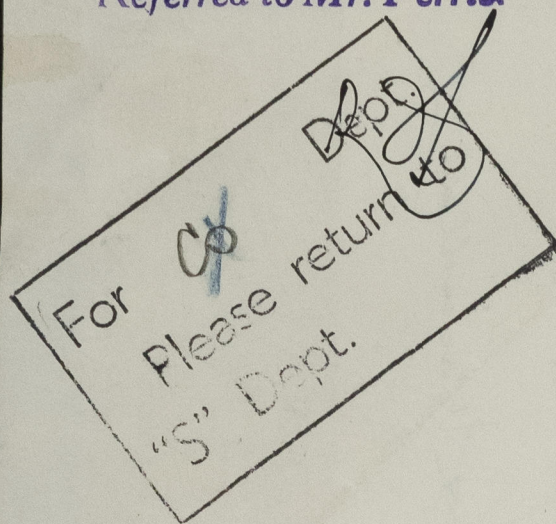
