This is to Certify that the *Main* Boilers  
made by *Messrs. J. S. Thornycroft & Co*  
for the *SS. "Poultan" No 1005* now "*LEASOWE*"  
and marked as below, have been surveyed during construction by the undersigned.  
The material has been tested by the Surveyors to Lloyd's Register; the scantlings  
are in accordance with the Society's Rules for a working pressure of *180* lbs.  
per square inch, and the workmanship is good. The Boiler having been  
tested in my presence on the *21<sup>st</sup> September 1921* by hydraulic pressure  
to *320* lbs. per square inch, showed no signs of weakness, and were  
found tight and sound in every respect at that pressure. Working pressure  
not to exceed *One hundred & eighty* lbs. per square inch.
