Dear Sir,

I acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 18th instant respecting the "TANGARA", the contents of which are noted.

In view of the age of the ship, however, it is considered that a much more extensive examination than the preliminary inspection which the Owner proposes would be necessary to enable him to reach a decision regarding repairs.

On receipt of a request signed by the Owner, the Committee would be prepared to instruct the Society's Surveyor at Rio de Janeiro to carry out a Special Survey for Reclassification and the Owner could then base his decision upon the repairs recommended by the Surveyor.

The fee charged should be in the neighbourhood of £200, plus any incidental expenses incurred by the Surveyor.
