

2 sets of 90 mm x 60 mm x 100 mm Worthington type
donkey boiler feed pumps, Nos. 2085-C and 2085-D.

The steam cylinders, valve chests and their
fittings were tested under hydraulic pressure of 14 kgs/cm²
with satisfactory results.

The pump barrels, valve boxes and their fittings
were tested under hydraulic pressure of 15 kgs/cm² with
satisfactory results.

marked as under:-




