Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in September 1936

NOW DONE: (cont.) See also previous memoranda dated 28.11.42 & 10.4.43.

- (1) Additional storage compartments (2 refrigerated chambers on S.S. aft in shelter tween deck space and one food store & wine cellar in former tonnage well not fitted. Opening in bulkhead at Fr 30 (from aft) p.s. not permanently closed by steel plates electrically welded.
- (2) Steel plate welded over top of coaming of tonnage hatch and efficiently stiffened by flat bars; strongly constructed steel companion way with steel door opened from both sides, coaming ^{30.1} ^{above deck} in above hatch coaming, now fitted for access to the above spaces and domestic (hot water) boiler compartment.
 (height of coaming)
- (3) Steel companionways at after end of no 1 & 2 hatches not removed and hatch wood covers re-fitted accordingly. Lifelines not satisfactorily provided on p.s. sides of shelter deck.
- (4) Two cargo ports previously fitted between frames 33 to 36 and frames 48 & 51 on port side only of shelter deck sheer strake not permanently closed by welding doors and hinges to shell plating. (frames numbered from prow)
