Dear Sir:-

In reply to your letter of January 18th with enclosure to Mr. C.F. Macdonald regarding his freeboard report on above vessel, the following are the particulars required.

Sheer at 1/8 length from forward 1'4"
Sheer at 1/8 length from aft 4 1/2"

These sheers were taken afloat in the Mississippi River as well as possible the vessel was ranging and the River was turbulent through flood. Draft to centre of disc as marked on the vessels side 14' 4". Length of poop from after side of sternpost 11'9". Moulded depth 18'4" measured by Mr. J.F. Robson while vessel was in drydock and is apparently the right figure.
