Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 24th ultimo forwarding New Orleans freeboard report No. 3052A and freeboard application form in respect of the Motor Vessel "KOSMOS I", but with regard thereto I have to state that it is observed the moulded depth is reported to be 18'-4", whereas the depth given on the First Entry Report is 18.01 ft., and I shall be glad if you will ascertain and let me know which figure is correct.

At the same time the sheers at $\frac{1}{8}$ th of the vessel's length from each end should be reported, also the draught approved as a condition of the class of the vessel.

It is observed that the length of the poop is measured over the stern, but I have to point out that the length from the after side of the sternpost should be reported.
