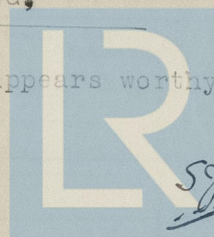
VESSEL'S NAME "EMPIRE TITAN" REPORT Mil. No. 5837
