My dear Willis, With reference to your letter of the 14th ultimo regarding Inissock Export Co. Steamship Co. Ltd. On Glasgow reports Nos. 62833 and 62373 on the boilers of the Admiralty vessels "L.C.8" and "LLANDUDNO", you will find that the boiler certificate numbers are the same in each case, viz:- 20566 and 20567.

If this is a clerical error, I shall be glad if you will kindly let me know, for record purposes, the correct certificate numbers in each case.

In the unfortunate event, however, of the same numbers having been taken by Messrs Anderson and Davis, and stamped on the respective boilers, I am afraid there is nothing we can do about it other than to bracket in our records the names of the two vessels against the certificate numbers referred to.


