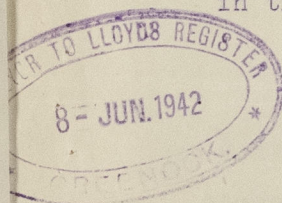

In reply to your letter of the 18th May we have to state that the steam pipes for the above vessel are made of Hot Rolled Weldless Steel manufactured by Messrs. Stewarts and Lloyds Ltd., Glasgow. The Advice Notes, signed by the Society's Surveyor, dated 5th December, 1940 covering this material have been examined and found in order, and the steam pipes tested by hydraulic pressure of 750 lbs per square inch in the presence of the Undersigned in March and April 1941.
