This vessel has arrived at the port of Bristol from the United States, making the journey under her own power and part loaded.

Upon arrival the Master reported that the vessel had suffered damage due to straining, and in his opinion was not seaworthy.

A request has now been received from the local agents, on behalf of the United States Army authorities, asking for a full report on the vessel's condition, but no details can be obtained as to the purpose she will be put to in the future.

We shall be pleased to receive instructions from you as to the procedure to be adopted in this case, but in the meantime arrangements are being made to commence the Survey of the vessel, as requested by the United States Army authorities.
