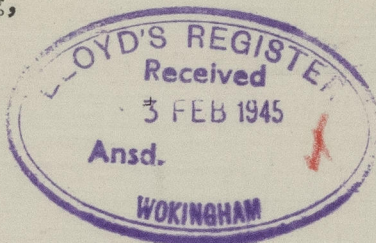

attention.

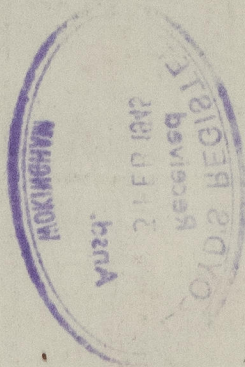
