I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 26th February with reference to Special Survey or General Examination and Load Line Survey to be held on the s.s. "EMPIRE GYPSY".

In this connection an enquiry was addressed to the Owners Agents who replied that the vessel had been bought by the Indian Navy and taken over by them as from 0001 hours on the 1st March 1948.

Thereupon, an enquiry was addressed to the Commodore, Naval Headquarters, Bombay regarding the maintenance of the vessel's class and a reply was received today stating it is not intended to maintain the vessel's class with Lloyd's Register.

This vessel R.F.A "EMPIRE GYPSY" is, therefore, no longer classed with this Society.
