Pumps connected to the main bilge line:-

Main engine driven plunger pump 4 1/4" dia. x 3" stroke.

Hamworthy centrifugal pump driven by auxiliary engine - 32 tons per hour capacity.

Downton 5" dia. hand pump.

E.R. direct bilge suction connected to main engine-driven bilge pump and through suction chest to other pumps.

Cooling water supplied by main engine-driven cooling water pump (similar to bilge pump) can also be supplied direct from sea by main engine-driven bilge pump, or by the Hamworthy pump.
