I enclose letter received from the Owner of the tugs "MEADOW" and "PIPER", and have to advise you that I have had an interview with Mr. Cooper.

These two tugs are practically confined to Belfast Harbour and have considerable slack time. The crews are maintained on board and the Owner, with the co-operation of the crew, carries through a continuous upkeep survey of hull and machinery, and wishes to avoid the additional expense in opening up when our surveys become due.
