I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 9th instant, and note your remarks.

The reports on this ship have been examined, and it is regretted that the record posted in column 7 of the 1944/1945 edition of the Register Book was made in error. The Report of Survey held at Bristol in April 1944 shows that only the cones of both screwshafts were examined at that time, but that the screwshafts were not drawn for examination.

Both screwshafts were drawn for examination at New York in September 1944 and a record of this inspection, with date of 9,44, was posted in the Register Book in respect of this inspection.

It will therefore be seen that the date of 9,44 was the operative date from which the incidence of subsequent inspections should be computed.
