~~DAMAGE &~~ WEAR AND TEAR.

Vessel placed in drydock and the screwshaft drawn and examined, the shaft was found to be pitted and one propeller blade broken. The shaft has now been replaced by one taken out of another vessel, this had evidently not been made under the Society's supervision and the Surveyor recommends the screwshaft be renewed before the end of 7,55. A new propeller fitted.


