Upon receipt of your communication of the 23rd ultimo, the case was submitted to the Committee today, when it was decided to bring the record in the Register Book into accordance with the facts.

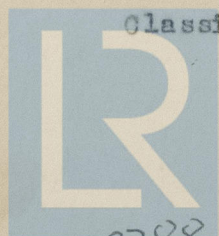
