The requisite General Examination was held but it was reported in the Shipping Papers that the vessel had been sold for breaking up in Finland. A notation of "To be broken up" was accordingly assigned on the 25th January and the Helsingfors Surveyor was advised accordingly.

The attached letter has now been received from the Helsingfors Surveyor intimating that they have received information from the Finnish Board of Navigation that the vessel has not been delivered for breaking up but is, in fact, still running. The Owners have enquired of the Surveyor whether they can now run the vessel with the Finnish Board
