The £3-5-6 for legalisation of the Certificate have been paid this morning, and owners requested me to thank you for the trouble taken in their behalf.

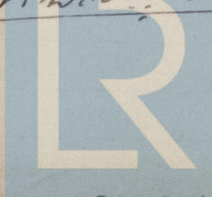
The Certificate on Hull has been handed in, that on the Machinery is retained in this office until Messrs. Crebter's consent has been received to part with it.

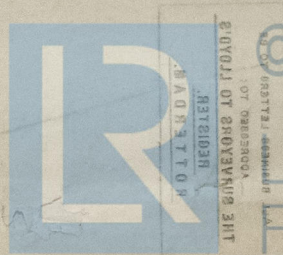
