Steamer "ASTRA"

With reference to your letter 'H' of the 6th. inst, regarding the overdue Special Survey and boiler and screw shaft surveys of the above named vessel, we enclose herewith a letter received from the Owners, together with a free translation of same, requesting withdrawal of class.

It may be added that we had several prior interviews with the Owners Marine Superintendent. This little tanker is now an entirely uneconomical proposition to operate and upon receipt of their consulting Surveyors estimated costs to carry out a full special survey, the Owners deemed it not advisable to spend further money on the vessel, especially since their other tanker the "ASTRA II" can carry all the Company's output of Petroleum products.
