Dear Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 28th. instant. relative to Middlesbrough First Entry Report No. 10884 on the S.S. "F.L.M. 12".

In reply to your enquiries, I have to state as follows, viz:-

- (1). A web frame frame is fitted at 107 frame as approved.
- (2). The Stiffeners on Bulkhead at frame No. 120 are spaced 24" apart.
- (3). The buttlaps of the A strake are 12" wide and quadruple riveted for $\frac{1}{2}$ length.
- (4). The rivets through frames and shed in way of 36" frame spacing are $5\frac{1}{2}$ diameter apart.
- (5). The tank top plating in way of hatchways has been increased .08 in lieu of ceiling.

The copy of the report has been corrected accordingly.
