In reference to my letter of the 7th instant respecting the freeboards for the steamers "MARTINIERE" and "**CAMBRONNE**", I beg to enclose herewith 5 request forms for freeboard filled in by the Owners for the steamers "**MONCOUSU**", **SAINT-TROPEZ**, **BRANCAS**, **GRANDLIEU** & **ST-FEREOL**".

The steamers will arrive in due course at this port starting with the steamer "**MONCOUSU**" about the 15th instant; "**SAINT-TROPEZ**" about the 21st instant; "**BRANCAS**" and "**GRANDLIEU**" about the 28th instant, and the "**SAINT-FEREOL**", about the 16th January 1933.
