("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

This ship is almost 34 years old.

A SPECIALS SURVEY (C) became due 1,55.

The Notation "Laid Up- Surveys Overdue - Class Suspended" appears in the Register Book.

The Owners have been informed that the Committee are prepared to consider postponement of the Special Survey until 9,55 provided a General Examination afloat is supplemented by a drydocking about the due date of survey.

The ROTTERDAM Surveyors report (2,55), ship examined in dry dock, bottom coated and the requirements of a General Examination partly complied with.

Repairs have been recommended to various items.

The Surveyors further state that before the survey was completed the present Owners decided to change over the Classification to Germanischer Lloyd.

In view of the above IT IS SUBMITTED for the consideration of the Committee whether the ship's class be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
