The Special Survey has been completed this time and the vessel will be recommended to remain as classed with fresh docking date 6-47 and to have notation for S.S. Rotterdam 6-47.

The original freeboard certificates have been transmitted to the Netherlands Authorities for extension by them until the end of the year of grace allowed for the next Special Survey ultimo November 1951.
