

GENERAL DECLARATION

(Received at London Office ..... 19..)

Place Hongkong Date 10th. May, 1927

We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct Surveyors to Specially Survey during Construction the Hull, and Boilers of the Vessel No. 636 building by Messrs. The Hongkong Wharves & Shipbuilding Co. Ltd., for Messrs. M.J. Ossorio, Manila, P.I.

Approximate Tons. Length 170'0" Breadth 29.0, Depth 13'3"  
to be Classed 100 A.1 Lloyds.

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connexion therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:-
