With reference to the case of the above named ship which it is understood is now your property, I would draw your attention to the fact that a Special Survey became due so long ago as August, 1955, and a Screwshaft Survey became due in September, 1956. The Loadline Certificate issued as a British ship expired on the 29th November.

It is observed from the shipping press that this vessel is still reported to be at Melbourne, and I shall be obliged if you will kindly let me know by return of post if practicable, whether you propose to maintain the vessel's class with this Society, in which case you should state what arrangements are proposed for the overdue surveys to receive attention.

Should the ship leave Melbourne without the surveys in question being held, there is little doubt that the Committee will immediately expunge the vessel's class from the Register Book.
