With reference to your classing letter of the 12th instant, and, in reply thereto regarding the above-named vessel, we beg to confirm that the re-examination of the main engine crankshaft which was recommended to be made before the end of July last (Msl.Rpt.N°.II837), was not carried out when the vessel was last attended in July last at this port for Condition and Screw Shaft Survey.

When the spare screw shaft was fitted and the stern bush bearing re-wooded in dry dock (Msl.Rpt.N°.II887), it was understood that the damaged after section of the crank shaft (dowels fitted) was intended to be renewed, subsequently, and the alignment of the intermediate shafting verified and dealt with accordingly."
