The Boulogne Surveyor reports this trawler placed on a slipway, bottom cleaned and coated and on account of damage during heavy weather and ranging, 4 shell plates have been renewed and 2 faired.

On account of wear and tear, renewals have been effected to casing, masts, steering chains, plating under galley etc. and minor repairs carried out.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 6,39.
