Reverting to your letter of the 14th October last regarding the "HELLENIC CHRYSSOULA", we understand this ship is still laid up in the Bristol Channel and that so far you have not made any arrangements to put in hand the extensive repairs recommended by the Cardiff Surveyors when they visited the ship in October last.

The Committee, to whom the case was referred today, cannot allow the class to remain undisturbed indefinitely, and unless you are prepared to put repairs in hand at an early date they feel they have no option but to expunge the vessel's class from the Register Book with a black line indicating reported defects.

Before doing so they have asked me to ascertain your reactions in time for their next meeting on Friday, the 5th instant.
