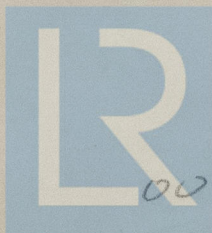
The difference of opinion to which Mr. Yannoulatos referred is not borne out by Mr. Van der Weel's remarks, and I think you will agree that some explanation is called for.
