Subject of Survey REPAIRS-TO-ENGINES-AND-BOILERS-DUE-TO-DAMAGE-THROUGH-

The history of this case is stated in Ship endorsement dated 3. 9. 47.

The Amsterdam Surveyors report that the main engine has been opened up throughout and extensive repairs, renewals and adjustments have been recommended to the machinery.

The boilers require to be examined and it is stated the vessel will be equipped with oil burning plant, necessitating alterations to pumping arrangements, etc. An electrical installation is also contemplated.

With the exception of the intermediate shafting and condenser, which have been examined and found in order, none of the recommendations have been carried out. The thrust shaft has been condemned on account of crack.

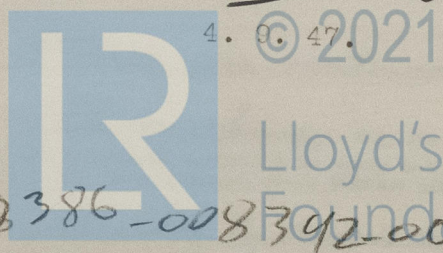
The Surveyors recommend that the vessel would be eligible to remain as classed when repairs and conversions have been carried out in accordance with the requirements of the Rules.

They, however, state that as the Owners desire to have the vessel classed with the British Corporation no further action has been taken.

IT IS ACCORDINGLY SUBMITTED the class of this vessel be expunged from the Register Book and a black line with date underneath inserted in lieu, indicating that the class has been withdrawn on account of reported defects.
