SHIP NAME "KOS 6" REPORT Os1. No. 8074.

The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/52.)

SPECIAL SURVEY(D) became due 5.55.

A proposal to postpone the Special Survey was approved and the Committee agreed to the ship's class remaining undisturbed in the Register Book on the understanding that arrangements would be made for the Special Survey to be dealt with when the ship was again placed in commission - see letter dated 19.5.55.

The Surveyors report 9.56 this ship afloat and submitted for Special Survey but it was subsequently decided that she should be laid up and the Survey was not proceeded with. There is no indication in the report as to when this will take place.

IT IS SUBMITTED for the consideration of the Committee whether a record of "Laid up pending Survey" be recorded in the Register Book or the class be expunged from the Register Book and notation of "Class Expunged - non-compliance with the Regulations (with date)" being inserted in the Register Book.
