The same Surveyors now report (9.49), the General Examination, as above, completed.

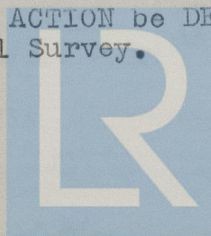
IT IS SUBMITTED the vessel is eligible to have record of docking 9.49.
