This vessel was built at Beverley under the Special Survey of this Society's Surveyors..

The engines were made by Messrs. Fraser & Chalmers, Erith, and the boiler by Messrs. James Neilson & Sons, and they were constructed and fitted on board under the supervision of the British Corporation Surveyors..

The screw shaft, propeller, stern tube and sea connections were made and fitted under the supervision of this Society's Surveyors.

A Certificate of their survey has been issued by the British Corporation to this Society and is attached hereto.

As it is provided in the Committee's Circular letter, dated 16th March 1918, that in such cases this Society will issue the machinery certificate with the notation of L.M.C. with date in red, it is submitted this vessel is eligible for the record of L.M.C. 9. 19.
