CERTIFICATE FOR THE CARRIAGE OF CARGO OIL IN BULK

This is to Certify that

F. BROOKE SMITH

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Messrs. The Indo-China Steam Navigation Co., Ltd., Shanghai, survey the four Deep Tanks of the steel twin screw steamer "PAO WO", 2517 tons gross, of Shanghai, whilst the vessel lay afloat at this port.

The Deep Tanks were tested on the 19th & 20th November 1930, by a eight foot head of water and upon examination, the boundary bulkheads, tank top, hatches, ventilators and other connections were found sound and tight.

The heating coils in the Deep Tanks were tested by steam pressure of 100 lb per square inch and found tight.

The Deep Tanks were finally examined Internally on the 27th November 1930, and found clean, free from rust, paint, scale, residue and moisture, and in good condition to receive a shipment of Cargo Oil in Bulk.
