Dear Sirs,

A. With reference to the fee chargeable to the Department of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding in connexion with the case of the S.S. "PEEBLES" (your first entry report No. 10380), I have to inform you that of the machinery fee of £36, one quarter will be due to the Newcastle Office for the survey of the boilers during construction, and the balance of £27 will be due to your port for the survey during construction of the engines, and installation on board.

I think it well to add that in future cases, the allocation of the proportions of the fees chargeable for the survey of the engines, boilers and installation on board should be in accordance with the practice established in the case of Standard Vessels, viz:- one-half for the survey of the engines, one quarter for the boilers and one quarter for the survey during installation on board.
