In March last, Shell (Eastern) Ltd., Singapore, stated this ship had been sold to Siong Huat Hardware Co. Ltd. for scrap. Her class was subsequently withdrawn by the Committee and a posting of TO BE BROKEN UP was made in the Register Book.
