I have to acquaint you that to complete the Boiler Survey of the steamer "PERLA" and to entitle her to the record B.S.11,39, the port boiler requires to be examined and all safety valves adjusted.

It was understood from the Port Said Surveyor in November that the Survey would be completed in Java. No report to this effect has however been received, and as the vessel appears to have arrived at Trieste on the 1st instant, I shall be glad if you will let me know how the case stands.
