I have to acquaint you that the subject matter of your letter of the 15th instant has received careful consideration.

Due note has been taken of your suggestion that in future cases we should advise the Registro Italiano that copies of actual computations cannot be furnished, and it is agreed that in the circumstances mentioned by you, there is some justification for your proposal.

Pending clarification of the Society's position vis-a-vis other Classification Societies, however, it is considered desirable that we should continue to furnish the R.I. with copies of Freeboard computations. We suggest, however, that a fee should be charged for this document, say one half the usual computation fee, and I shall be glad to learn whether you consider this amount to be reasonable.
