

Mr. Roberts called on behalf of Owners, and stated they had not sufficient dollar credit to undertake full survey repairs in Mobile as required by Mob. Rpt. He was advised of condition of ship as disclosed in the Reports and stated he would communicate with Owners and suggest that vessel proceed to Genoa without cargo. If agreed, he would then request Committee to reconsider the matter with a view to obtaining interim certificate for vessel to proceed in ballast to Genoa for completion of all Special Survey repairs, after the repairs considered necessary by the Mobile Surveyors for the voyage had been carried out.
