In acknowledging your letter of the 4th inst. with reference to freeboard report No 5261 on the steamer "Vincia" I beg to inform you as follows—

The approved plans asked for, were forwarded to the London office with the 1st Entry report for the tug "Doria" one of three built by the same builders. A copy of the original midship section submitted is enclosed herewith

The length of the bridge house fitted is 18'-9" and the height 4'-3" between decks.

There is an efficient bulkhead at the fore end of bridge, the only openings in it being two 4" port lights. The vessel is designed to trim 5 ft by the stern when loaded
